

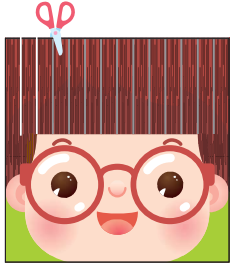
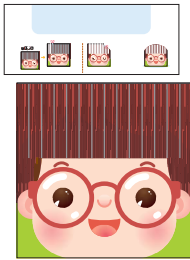
Cut Hair

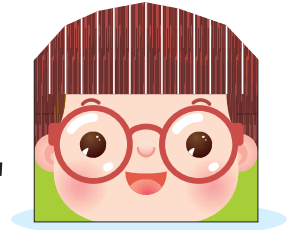

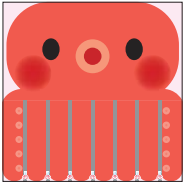
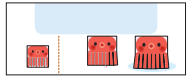


Make an Octopus

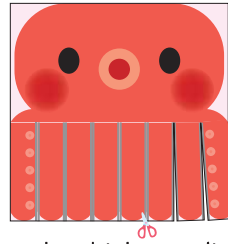

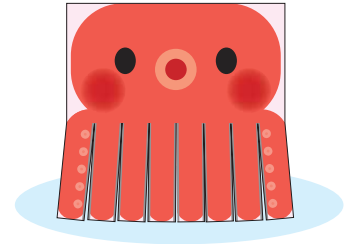

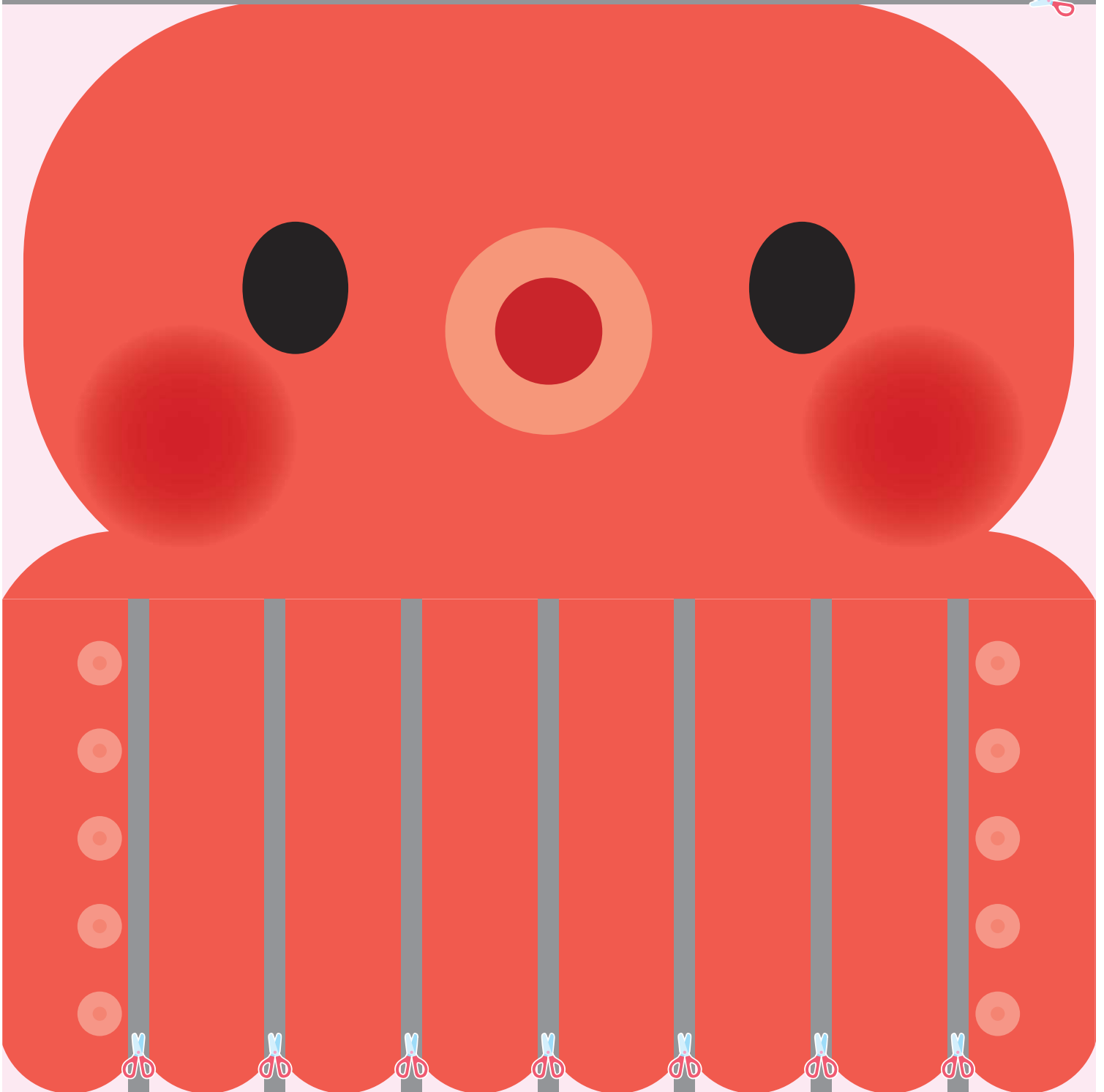

Make a Bird and a Fish

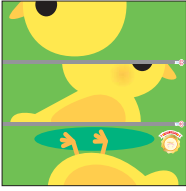

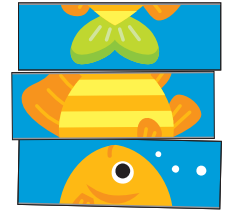

1 Cut the thick gray lines.

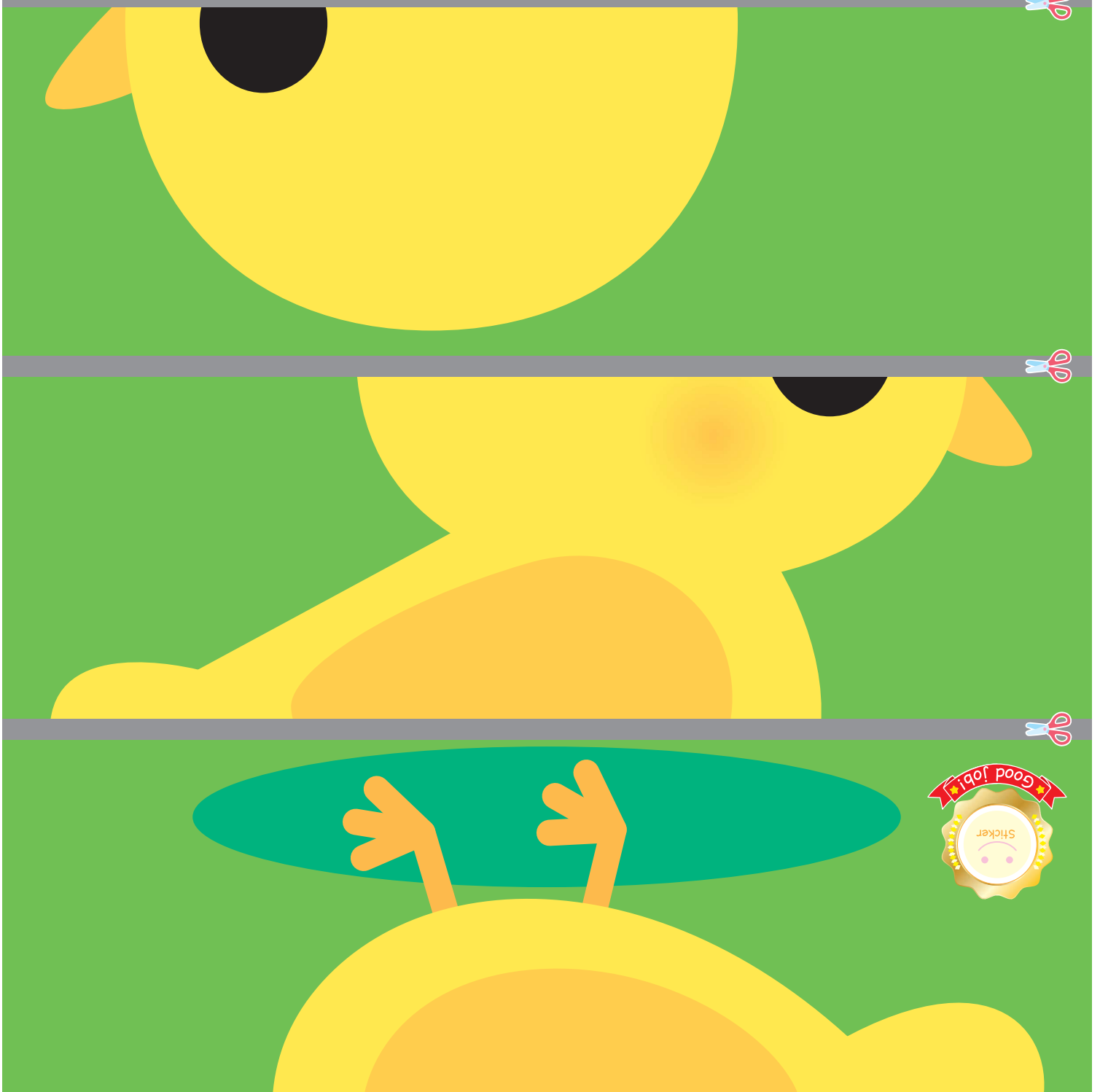


2 Put the pieces together to make a bird.

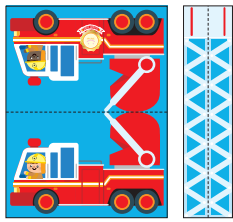
Make a Fire Truck

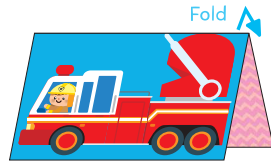

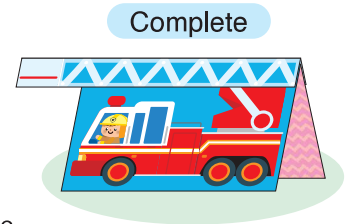
1 Cut the thick gray lines.
