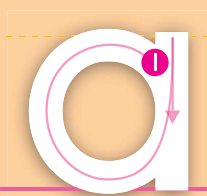
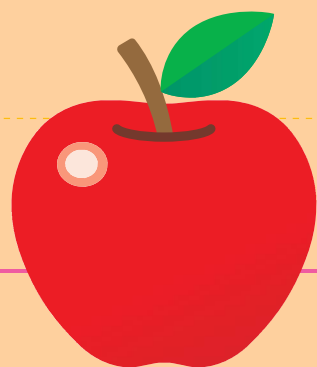
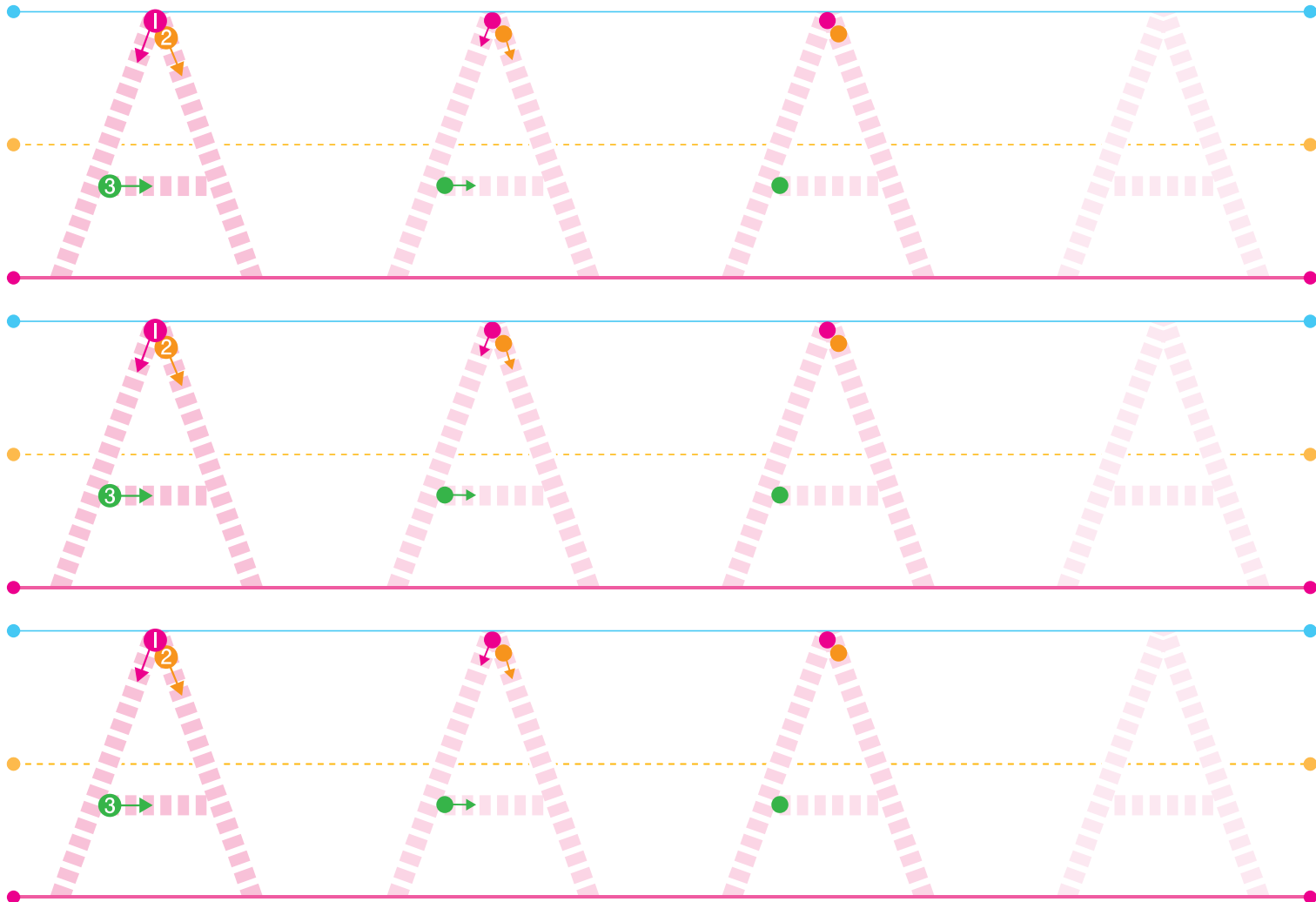


Letters Trace each letter.



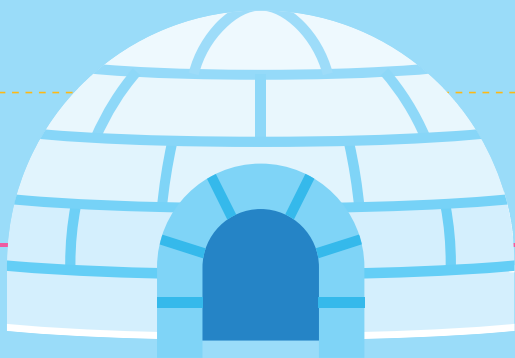

To Parents: Allow your child to use their finger to trace the letter before using a pencil. This will help orient their eyes to the shapes they are about to draw.



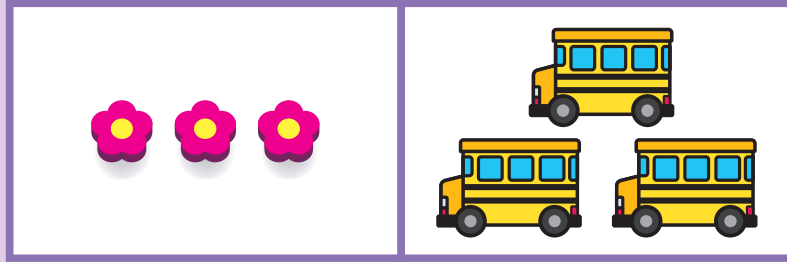

To Parents: Show your child the three flowers on the page. Emphasize that the number 3 represents three objects—in this case, three flowers.

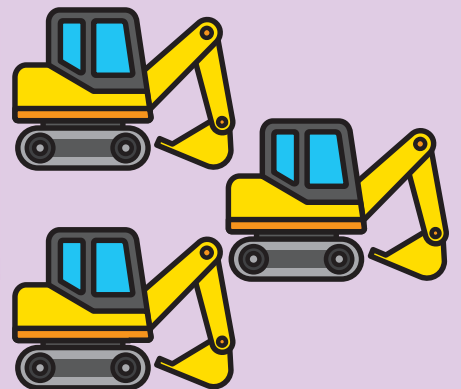
