

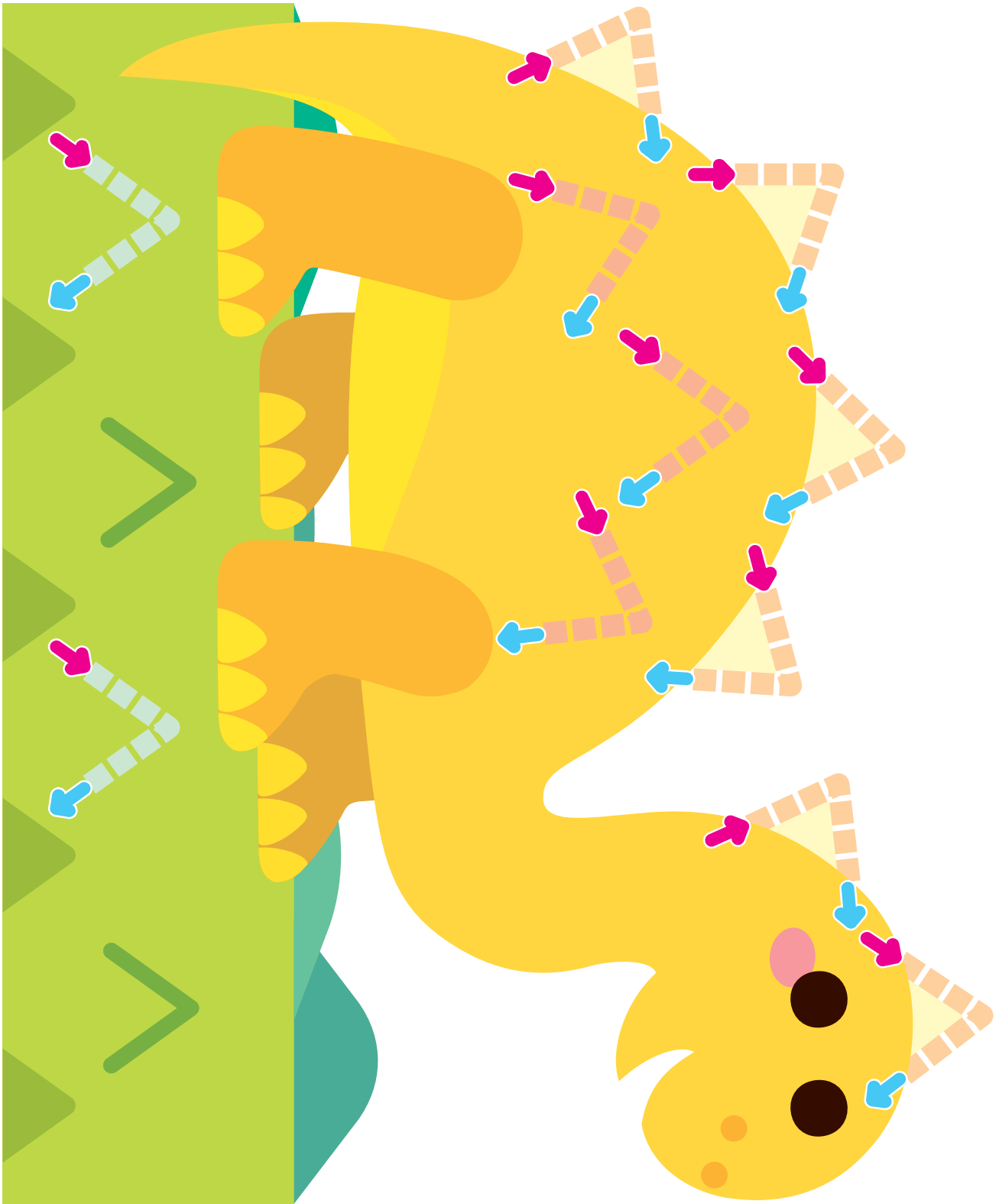


Draw Jagged Lines

To Parents: This activity focuses on drawing jagged lines. Encourage your child to stop at each bend before changing direction.



Draw lines from  to .



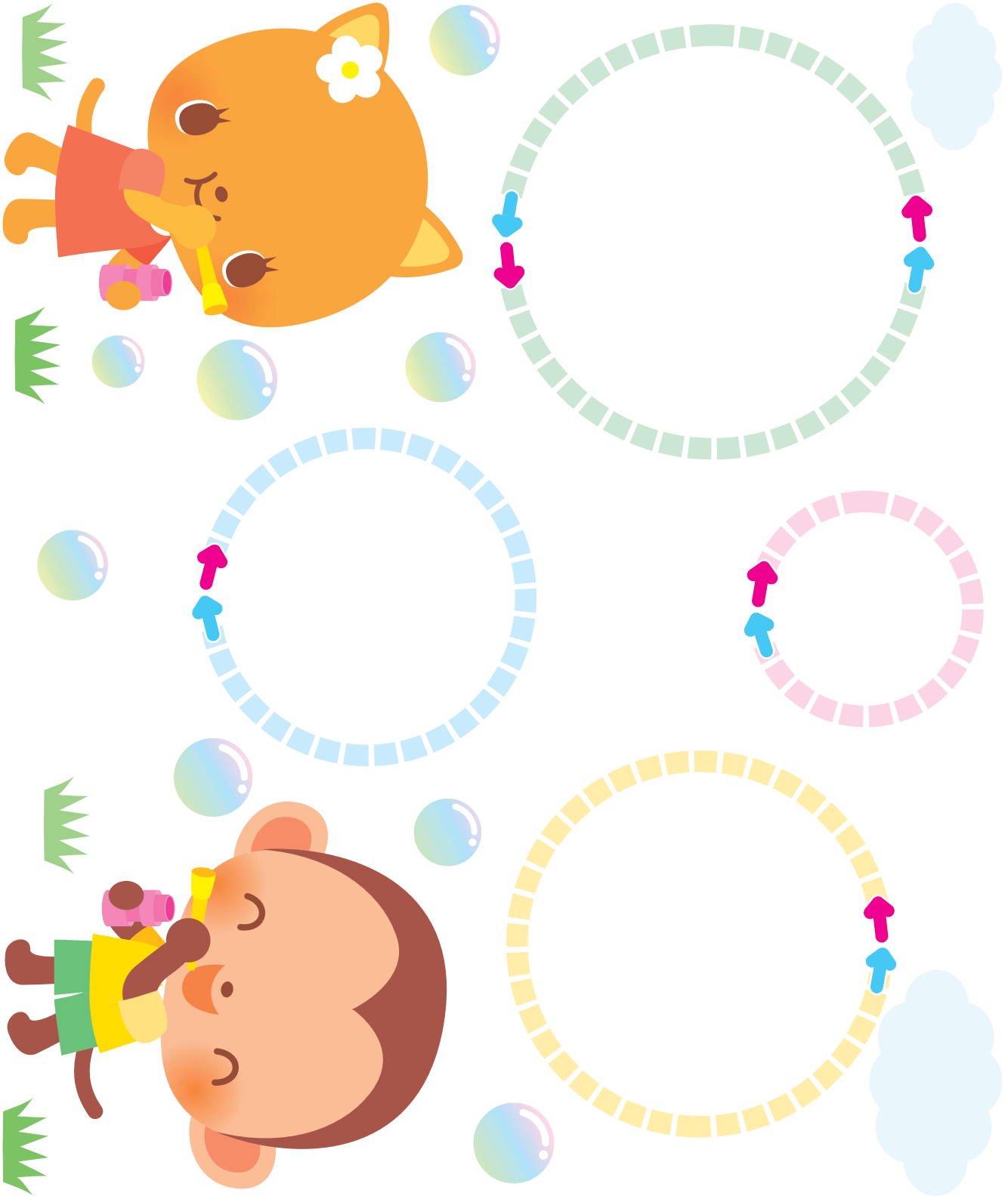


Play with Bubbles

To Parents: Start by asking your child to draw only half the circle, not the entire circle. When your child is done, say, "Well done! How about coloring in the circle?"

Go Through the Maze

To Parents: To begin, hold your child's finger and help them trace the path. This activity helps children develop visual scanning.

Draw an Airplane

To Parents: The airplane below uses straight and curved lines. It's okay if your child takes a break and puts down the crayon. But encourage them to also try drawing continuously.
