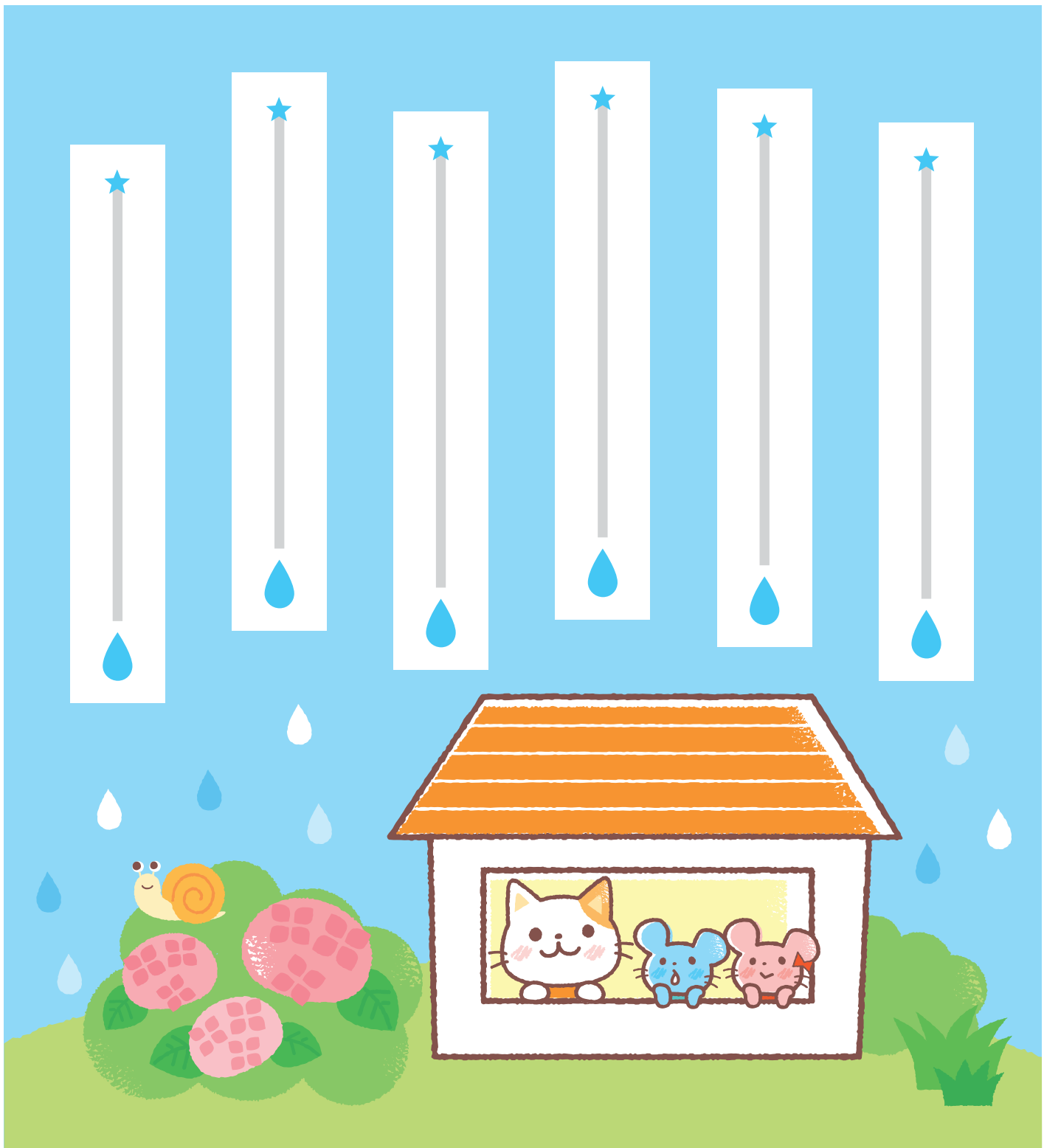


# Let's Trace Straight Lines

The animals are watching the rain. Trace the lines from ★ to ● to make the rain fall.




# Let's Match the Animals

Draw a line from one panda to the other panda.

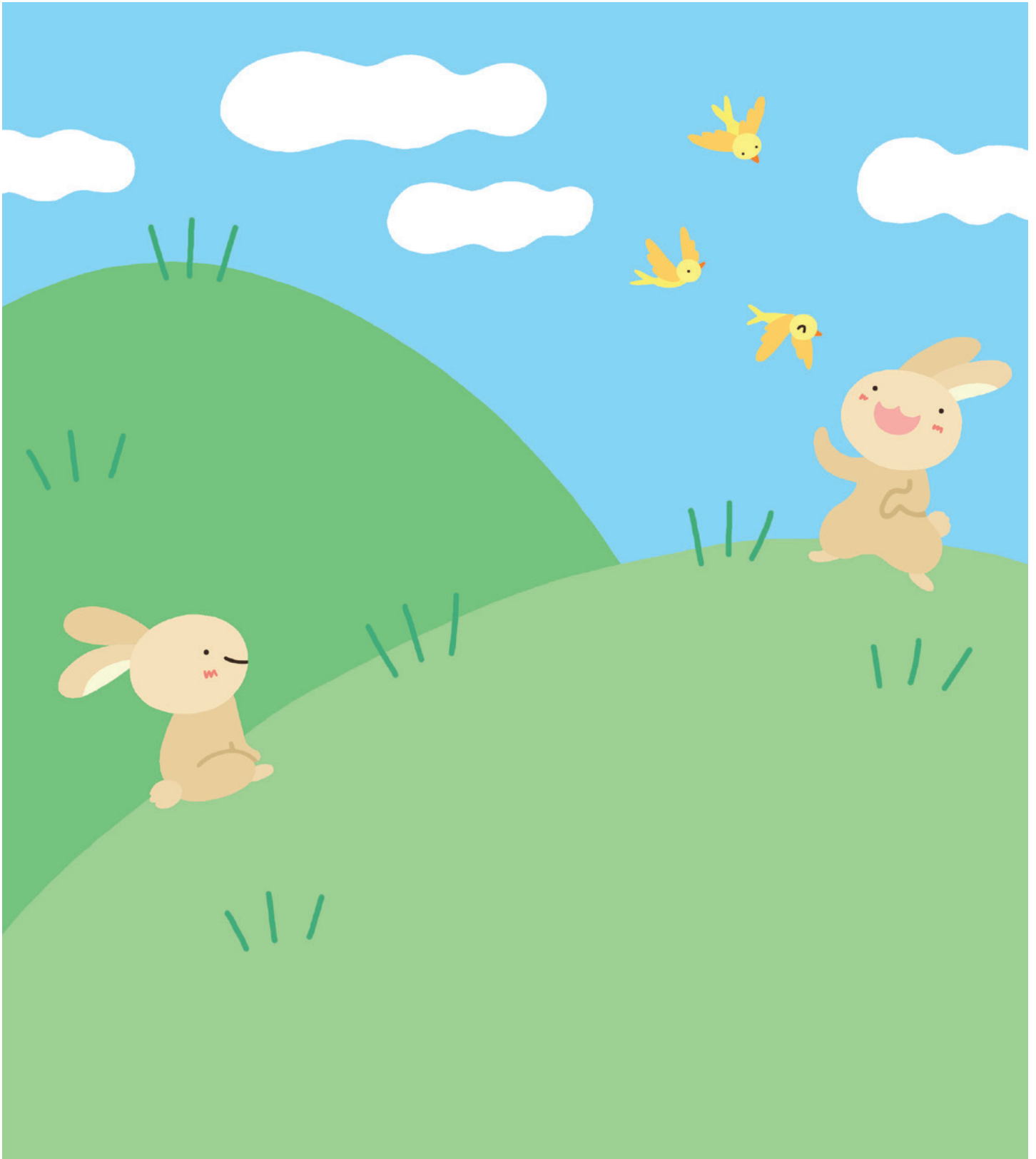


# Let's Draw Grass
