To Parents: Have your child draw a path through the star maze. Encourage him or her to stay on the white path and avoid crossing over any lines.



Let's go through the star. Draw a line from  to .



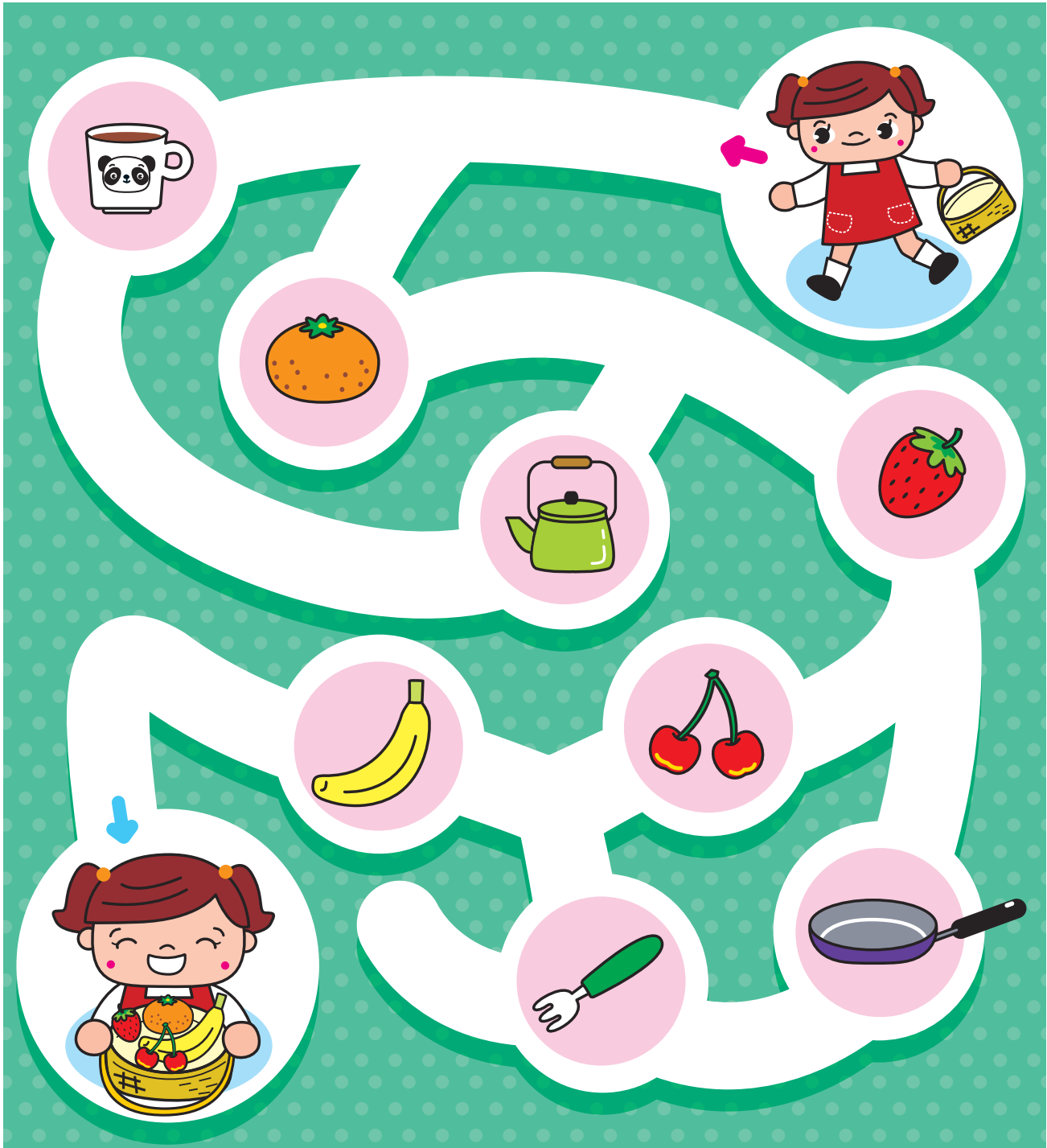
Let's Gather Fruit

To Parents: This activity is designed to help your child recognize similar objects. Have your child follow the path from fruit to fruit. Ask your child to try to name each item in the maze.



Help the girl fill her basket with fruit. Follow the path that has only fruit.

Let's Count

To Parents: This activity is designed to help your child learn to count. Have your child count the chunks of cheese in each box. He or she should draw a path from one box filled with three cheeses to the next.



Draw a line from  to , by only going through groups of three cheeses.
